Elementary World Language

Third Grade

Third grade World Language is a continuation of language learning from Kindergarten through second grade focused on communicative language acquisition through listening, reading, speaking, and writing in the target language. Students will synthesize previously studied concepts to expand and reinforce real-world applications of language study as well as explore various cultural traditions. Throughout the course, students will engage in activities to study school supplies and school subjects, healthy foods and mealtimes, clothing, and shopping. These skills are taught via scaffolding curriculum that capitalizes on sharpening previously studied concepts while introducing new skills to expand current language capacities.

Unit Description	Content and/or Skills
Las materiales escolares: Students will recognize and orally express vocabulary and simple grammatical patterns related to school supplies and school subjects.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Utilize vocabulary related to school supplies and subjects● Express school supplies that are needed for each class● Explain what is done during different school subjects i.e. <i>“En la clase de español, me gusta hablar español.”</i>● Ask and answer simple questions related to school i.e. favorite classes, what is needed, etc.● Students will develop the skills to read, write, listen and speak in Spanish
La comida: Students will recognize and orally express vocabulary and simple grammatical patterns related to healthy food and mealtimes.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Utilize vocabulary related to healthy foods and mealtimes● Determine whether foods are healthy or unhealthy● Describe foods based on size, shape, texture, and taste● Categorize food by which meal the foods are eaten● Express preferences for various foods● Students will develop the skills to read, write, listen and speak in Spanish

<p>La ropa II: Students will recognize and orally express vocabulary and simple grammatical patterns related to clothing.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Utilize vocabulary related to clothing● Explain clothing worn during different weather conditions and seasons● Describe and categorize clothing by color and patterns● Express how much an item costs● Ask and answer questions related to clothing i.e. size, color, price, pattern, etc.● Students will develop the skills to read, write, listen and speak in Spanish
<p>Las compras: Students will recognize and orally express vocabulary and simple grammatical patterns related to shopping.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Utilize vocabulary related to shopping (both in terms of food shopping and clothing shopping)● Express how much an item costs● Express preferences for shopping● Ask and answer simple questions related to shopping i.e. Who? What? Where? When? How much? etc.● Students will develop the skills to read, write, listen and speak in Spanish
