Elementary World Language

Kindergarten

Kindergarten World Language is an introduction to language learning focused on communicative language acquisition through beginning listening, reading, speaking, and writing in the target language. Students will be introduced to foundational skills vital to learning a second language and explore various cultural traditions. Throughout the course, students will engage in activities to study colors, shapes, numbers, family members, school supplies, and animals.

Unit Description	Content and/or Skills
La introducción: Students will begin to build a foundation of simple Spanish vocabulary.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Identify vocabulary for colors, shapes, and numbers● Express emotions/feelings● Utilize a variety of greetings and farewells● Identify and create patterns of colors and shapes● Students will develop the skills to begin to read, write, listen and speak in Spanish
La familia: Students will recognize and orally express vocabulary related to family.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Utilize vocabulary related to family● Identify family members through art and familiar characters● Students will develop the skills to begin to read, write, listen and speak in Spanish
La clase: Students will recognize and orally express vocabulary related to the classroom.	<ul style="list-style-type: none">● Identify vocabulary related to the classroom● Understand and respond to simple classroom commands i.e. “<i>Stand up.</i>”, “<i>Sit down.</i>”, etc.● Comprehend simple directions in Spanish● Students will develop the skills to begin to read, write, listen and speak in Spanish

Los animales: Students will recognize and orally express vocabulary related to pets and other animals.

- Identify vocabulary related to pets and other animals
- Identify if animals live at a house or at a farm
- Express preferences for animals i.e. *"I like dogs."*
- Students will develop the skills to begin to read, write, listen and speak in Spanish
