

- Teacher/student (voice & feedback)


Professional Development

Learning Rounds

- Evaluation and Observation Plan and Responsive Curriculum Model
- Lens for Rounds
 - Content and/or Skill
 - Aspect of the lesson (calibration)
- Administrative Team
 - CO, Building, Curriculum
- Teacher Learning Rounds
 - Inter-school visitation
- Alignment and Best Practices



Curriculum Writing and Revising

- Consistency across content and grade levels
 - Development
 - Format
- Ensures alignment and progression of learning K-12
- Memorialized on websites
 - Parents
 - \circ Teachers

Supervision and Evaluation

- Formal Observations
 - Pre/Post observations
- Increased informal observations
 - Walk throughs
 - Alignment and consistency across courses
 - Professional Learning Communities
- Co-observations with the administrative team
 - Common lens
 - School-wide initiatives
 - Co-teaching models
- Increased content specific feedback



Model/Coach

- Real-time feedback in classroom
- Individual and small group feedback sessions
- Co-Taught Classes, co-coaching (interdisciplinary)
- Problem solving with teachers
- Colleague-to-colleague coaching/modeling
