





Special Education Extended School Year Program ESY Program Overview

The Darien Public Schools Extended School Year (ESY) Program provides special education and related services to eligible students with an Individualized Educational Program (IEP) during June and July of the academic year.

Each student's Planning and Placement Team (PPT) determines eligibility for the ESY Program on an individual basis. The PPT members consider:

- Nature and severity of the student's disability;
- Learning needed to attain independence;
- Extent of regression caused by an interruption in educational programming; and,
- Rate of recoupment following interruption in educational programming

Special Education Extended School Year Program Program Overview & Goals

The Darien Public Schools Extended School Year (ESY) Program provides special education and related services to eligible students with an Individualized Educational Program (IEP) during June and July of the academic year.

Building on the successes and feedback from the 2019 ESY Program, goals for the 2020 ESY Program included:

- Timely and detailed communication with families
- Early program planning at the school and District level
- Reviewing past data to drive efficient hiring and resource deployment
- Continued use of a priority structure for assigning students and staff
- Ongoing communication with transportation vendor

Special Education Extended School Year Program Achieved Goals for 2020

In addition to our ongoing goals of early program planning and timely, clear, and responsive communication, the Special Education Department achieved the following goals:

Collaboration with Darien Summer School (DSS)

• Detailed explanation at PPT meetings regarding the alignment of DSS classes to students' IEP goals (e.g., why the PPT might recommend a specific DSS class as part of the student's ESY Program)





Special Education Extended School Year Program 2020 Program Planning Timeline




Special Education Extended School Year Program Student Enrollment
