Special Education Extended School Year Program

• Students with an Individualized Educational Program (IEP) may be eligible for an Extended School Year (ESY) Program. Students with ESY services may also participate in the Darien Summer School Program.

• Students are determined eligible for an ESY Program at Planning and Placement Team (PPT) meetings.

K-12 ESY Program Structure

• The ESY Program was held from June 27, 2016 through July 29, 2016. Instruction and Related Services were provided Monday – Friday, 8:30am - 12:30pm

Some students participated in up to two extension weeks (Bridge Weeks), if recommended at a PPT meeting

• Darien High School hosted students in grades K-12 who participated in the ESY Program

• Transportation was provided for students attending the program

PK Summer Programs: Structure

- •Tokeneke Elementary School hosted the Early Learning Program (ELP) and the Kindergarten Readiness Program for pre-kindergarten students with IEPs and typically developing students an integrated learning program
- •The program was held from July 5, 2016 through August 11, 2016. Instruction and Related Services were provided Monday Thursday, 8:00am 11:45am
- Transportation was provided for students attending the program

ESY Programs Student Enrollment

299 students with IEPs attended the 2016 ESY Programs:

- •237 students in grades K-12 attended the ESY Program at DHS
- •62 PK students attended the programs at Tokeneke

ESY Program Staffing

- Staffing was determined based on the ESY Program (instruction and service hours) recommended at their PPT meetings.
- A total of 127 staff working collaboratively in the ESY and ELP Programs:
 - Teachers, Paraprofessionals, Speech and Language Pathologists, Occupational Therapists, Physical Therapists, Psychologists, Nurses, Board Certified Behavioral Analysts

Darien Summer School: Background

- Comprehensive, diversified, learner-centered program
- Available to all students (Darien and other communities) in grades Pre-K through 12th grade
- 199 choices:
 - Academic classes, to include high school credit courses as well as enrichment
 - Variety of athletic, art, music and theatre programs

Structure of Program

- 5 week program
- Runs June 27, 2016 through July 29, 2016
- 7:30-8:30am extended day option (Cancelled due to low enrollment)
- 8:30-12:30pm (2 hour courses)
- 12:30–3:30pm, extended day offerings
- Weekly sports camps (varied times)

Structure of Program

Middlesex Jump Start:

- Takes place the first 2 weeks of DSS
- Available to all 5th grade students transitioning to MMS
- 5th grade students from all 5 el's are invited

Summer Pals Program (Tokeneke):

- 5 week program
- Available to children aged 3-5 designed to promote kindergarten readiness

Student Enrollment

- Total class registration 1,905 students
- Many students are enrolled in multiple classes

Staffing

- 125 staff members:
 - Certified teachers, athletic coaches and DHS student assistants
